Restore the traditional values of the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes and help our communities return to a healthier lifestyle



Using an innovative funding structure to create sustainably funded services for all patients regardless of race or income


Capturing reimbursement outside of the walls of IHS to provide treatment in a community based setting

Developing a funding model that is MORE sustainable in a high poverty setting where a large percentage of population covered by Medicaid


Capitalizing on high Medicaid reimbursement rate for Native American population receiving care on a reservation




